## Context for Teaching


#### Abstract

I am a math teacher at DaVinci Academy of Arts \& Science in Blaine, MN, and I am very successful. I teach $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade math standards as well as geometry and math support. As a middle school math teacher, my students average a $92 \%$ MCA passing rate and a $70 \%$ MCA exceeds rate. Our school in general is a high-achieving school (coincidentally since l've been there) and we are a 5 out of 5 reward school and this year we became a Blue Ribbon school. I am the curriculum coordinator for middle school math and we use the Holt Curriculum which is common amongst surrounding districts. We have about a $15 \%$ SPED population and about a $25-30 \%$ diversity rate. There is a $0 \%$ discrepancy between low-income and normal/high income. We have 1 ELL student and dozens of gifted and talented students. We are about $75 \%$ low-middle income and about $25 \%$ high income. We are a charter school that has a lottery system. Only 50 students get in per year out of 600 . As for middle school, we have 1-to-1 chrome book for each class and we utilize technology as much as we can. I am currently the middle school leader and run a ski club in the winter. We take a yearly trip to Eagle Bluff to build rapport and buy-in with students. High expectations run throughout our school and we try to teach the DaVinci Way to new teachers and new students. It is a school effort.
