Q1: How are your personal and professional ethics displayed on a daily basis?

- We have to treat all students equally and make sure they are not being labeled.
- We continually assist in anti-bullying discussions and model proper behavior
- Communication must be kept confidential and a supervisor should be cc'd
- Our language must remain professional (no flirting, swearing, discriminatory talk)
- Clear boundaries are made including things like hugging

Q2: What is the MAIN reason you would or would not hire Coach Joe?

- I truly felt that there simply wasn't enough time between his incarceration and his coaching students. I think 5 years more down the road allows him to then have the conversation.
- I'm not sure time would be the matter here. If a teacher or administrator had been dealing, doing and running meth, we would never be able to be hired. But since it's a coach of football, we can justify skirting the rules because he's good at his job. I'm a good teacher and if I dealt meth to people, I'd never work again.

Q3: What is one thing you learned from the ethics resources and assignment?

• That sometimes making a decision with the heart can be costly. Sometimes there must be a bottom line with the big picture.
