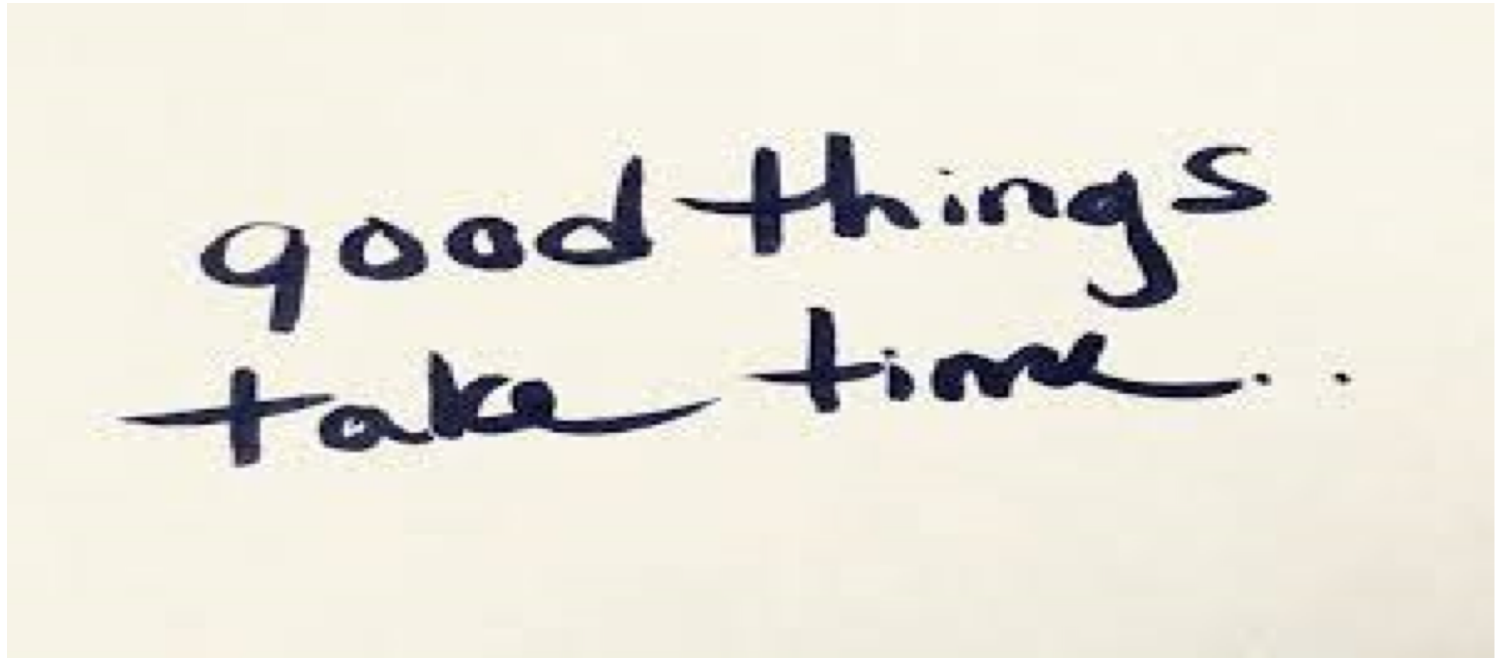


How Do We Change?

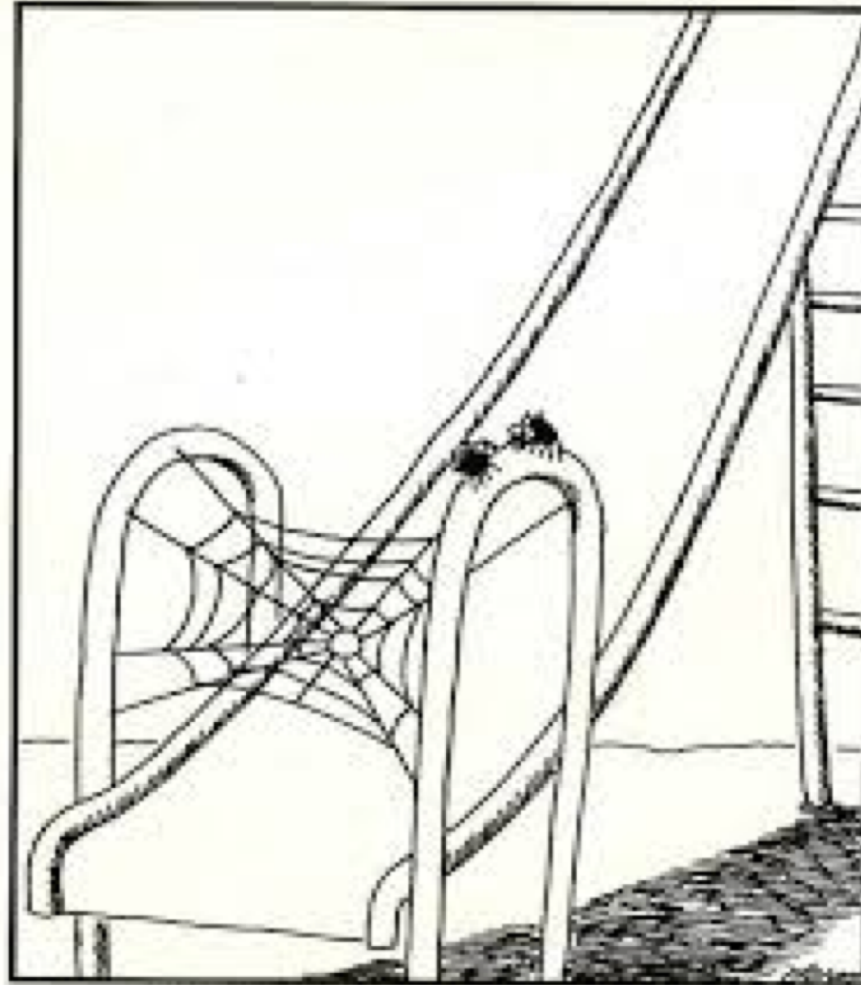

Use clarifying questions and be ready to paraphrase ideas for clarity



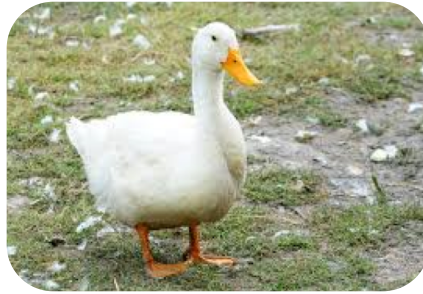
Videotaping is ok!



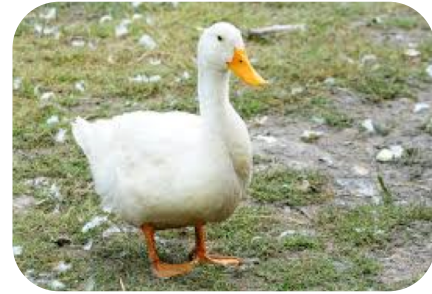

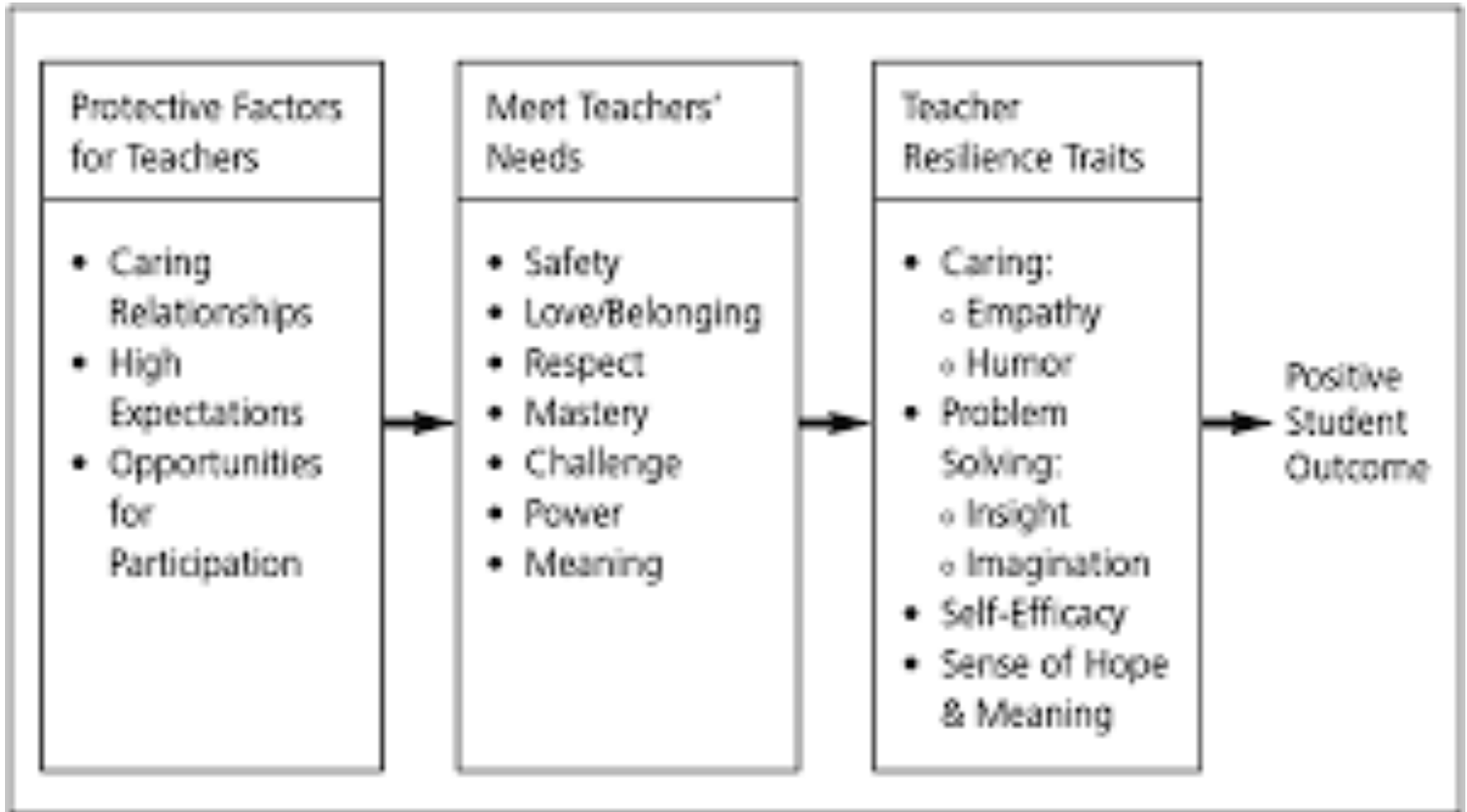
